



Magnolia UCC In-Person Sunday Attendance Guidelines

- Please stay home if one of these apply
 - a. You have a fever / running a temperature of 100.4 or more
 - b. You are experiencing any symptoms such as: headache, runny nose, cough, sore throat, diarrhea/vomiting, loss of taste or smell, shortness of breath, and/ or body aches
 - c. Anyone in your home is sick
 - d. You have been exposed to the Corona virus in the last 14 days and have not had a test confirming that you are not carrying the virus
- **Masks must be worn at all times**
- Attendees must register ahead of time to reserve a spot by contacting Camberly at contact@magnoliaucc.org. Spots will be assigned based on timing of registration and priority will be given to individuals who have not had a chance to participate.
- A total of 5 individual spots will be reserved each week for individuals who would like to attend in-person worship in the Sanctuary. Family units may sit together. The total number of participants will not exceed 5 on any given Sunday. Names will be added to a waiting list as needed.
- You will be notified by Camberly if a spot is available for the Sunday worship and you will also be notified what color ribbon you are assigned.
- **Participants are asked to arrive between 9:40 and 9:50am to minimize noise in the sanctuary once the streaming has begun. Please plan on arriving no later than 9:50 am.** The worship team will be focused on last minute preparation, so you are invited to take your seat when you arrive. We will begin live streaming by 9:55.
- Once you arrive in the building, you will see your assigned color ribbon and your bulletin on the table in the Narthex as you enter. Please take the ribbon and the bulletin and find the corresponding bow and take your seat.
- Participants will be seated in the back 1/3 of the sanctuary and are asked to not go to the front of the sanctuary before, during or after the worship service
- Participants are asked to take a seat in a designated pew, the service will be live streamed and so we ask that you minimize moving around during the service and making noise.
- If participants choose to sing or join in the prayers, masks must stay on and we ask that you sing or pray softly
- If participants would like to make an offering, a small basket will be left on the ledge as you exit the Sanctuary
- After the worship if participants become ill, please notify the Church Office
